## Instructions for taxi drivers - HOW TO FIND US

A blown-up map is on the next page, for your convenience

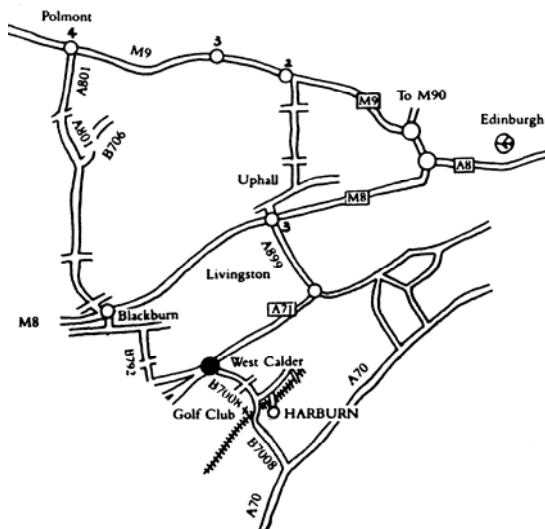
### From Glasgow

#### From Edinburgh

Follow the Airport and Glasgow signs to M8 motorway. Take the M8 and come off at the first exit (J 3) for Livingston. Keep left and join the A899 (dual carriageway). You come to a large roundabout called the Lizzie Brice where you turn right signed A71 for Kilmarnock. Keep on through Polbeth and you come to West Calder. Turn left at the traffic lights in West Calder signed B7008 to Harburn.

**Go 2 miles exactly till Harburn Golf Course is on your right. Turn left at the golf course by the post box (before the railway bridge). Harburn gates are 250 yards from golf course on the right at the end of the row of cottages**

**Follow M8 signs to Edinburgh. Join the M8 and come off at junction 4. Follow road UNDER the motorway and turn left to join main road, A705 Whitburn/Livingston road. Go approximately 1 mile to Blackburn and turn right at the lights on the B792, through Addiewell, to West Calder. In West Calder at T-junction turn left and almost immediately right onto B7008. Go 2 miles exactly till Harburn Golf Course is on your right. Turn left at the golf course by the post box (before the railway bridge). Harburn gates are 250 yards from golf course on the right at the end of the row of cottages**



### From the South

M1, M6, A74, M74  
Turn off at junction 12 and take the A70 to Carnwath (mainly signed to Edinburgh). In Carnwath turn left on the A70 to Edinburgh. Go approximately 9 miles and take the B7008 signed to West Calder. After approximately 1½ / 2 miles, over a railway bridge turn right by the post box (Harburn Golf Club on your left). Harburn gates are on the right after the last cottage.

### From the North

Over the Forth Road Bridge, take left-hand lane and turn left on to the A8000, go straight over first roundabout following signs for Airport, M8 and Glasgow. Turn right at second roundabout and follow dual carriageway to junction 2 (Newbridge roundabout) on the M8. Continue on M8 and follow signs from now on as on the Edinburgh instructions.
